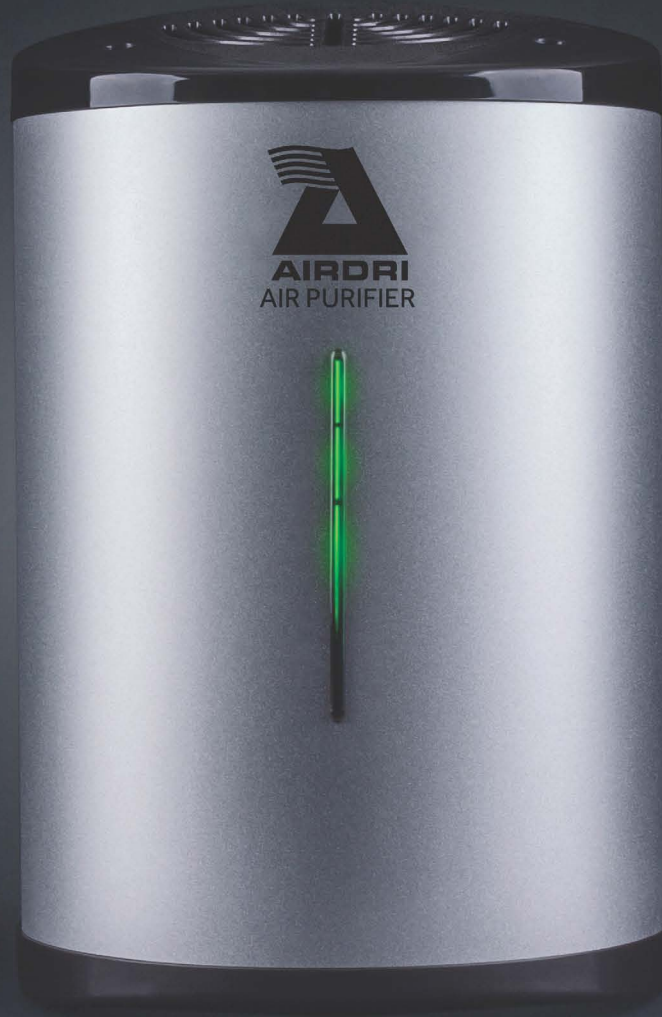

- * For larger spaces additional units can be used.
- * The Air Purifier is wall mounted for continuous operation via a fused spur, or plugged in.

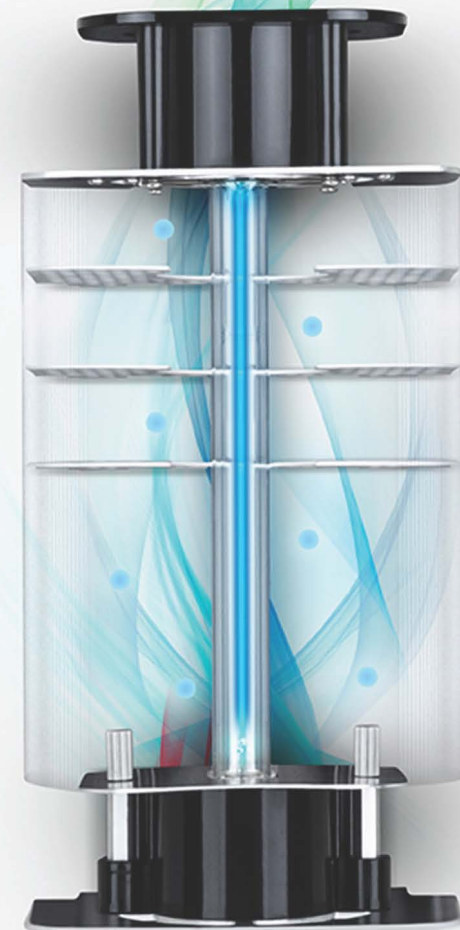

SERVICING MADE EASY:

- * Power must be disconnected before attempting any servicing and only undertaken by a competent individual.
- * The cover is easily removed by taking out four screws.
- * Any dust or debris build up should be cleared from the fan and interior.
- * Lamps must be changed on an annual basis to maintain performance.
